Adults who do not have their own boat: £115.00

Please note:

- If you have your own boat you pay a racking fee of £65.00*
- Members joining throughout the year will be charged membership fees pro rata
- New members with their own boat pro rata = £4.17 per month
- New members without their own boat pro rata = £9.59 per month
- If new members have paid for Taster Sessions then the money paid will be taken into account
